
Below we highlight the Christmas in July Shoeboxes. Please read the information and plan on participating in July!



GENTLY USED AND CLEAN CLOTHING IS ACCEPTABLE (EXCLUDING underwear, socks and flip flops—THESE ITEMS ARE TO BE NEW). Please use the following guideline: If you would not given in the item in question wrapped as a gift to your child, grandchild or best friends child, then please do not include the item in your Christmas Shoe Box.

Please do not include the following:

- NO TOOTHPASTE
- NO books, games, activities in English. The children DO NOT SPEAK English. English is not spoken in the home or at school.
- NO swimming suits
- NO long sleeve shirts, long pants, pajamas
- NO food, candy or chewing gum of any kind
- NO liquids of any kind, no shampoo, hand sanitizer, lotion, etc.
- NO chapstick, make-up, nail polish
- NO TOYS THAT CONTAIN LIQUID OR GEL SUCH AS BALLS WITH SUSPENDED GLITTER OR SPARKLES
- NO SLIME
- NO silly putty, kinetic sand, molding clay
- NO Off Brand Play Dough, PLAY DOUGH MUST BE NAME BRAND
- NO toy guns, weapons, soldiers, NO WAR TOYS
- NO playing cards or collection cards of any kind
- NO balloons, punching balls. These are choking hazards for young children
- One child development and educational card game is acceptable. As long as not in English.
