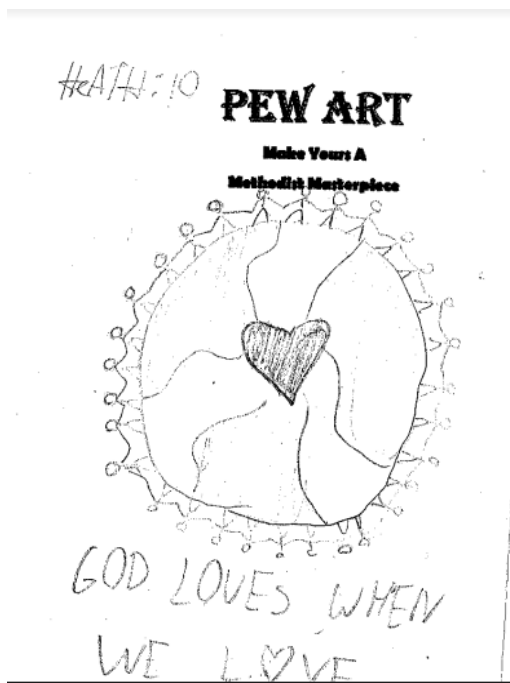
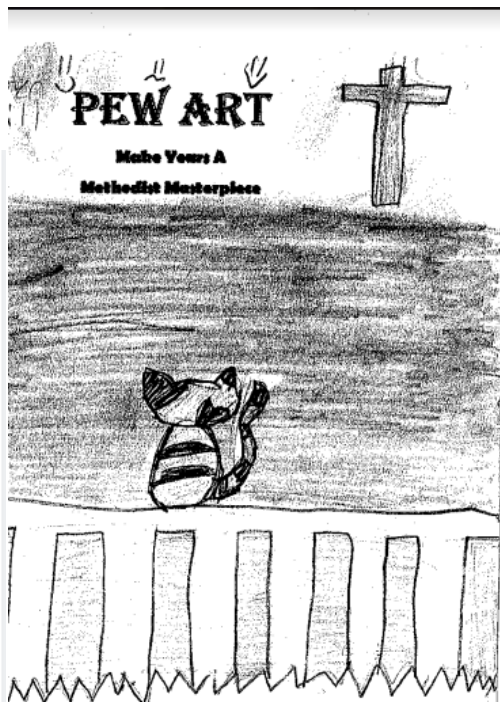
### PEW ART FOR NOVEMBER
