## VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL!

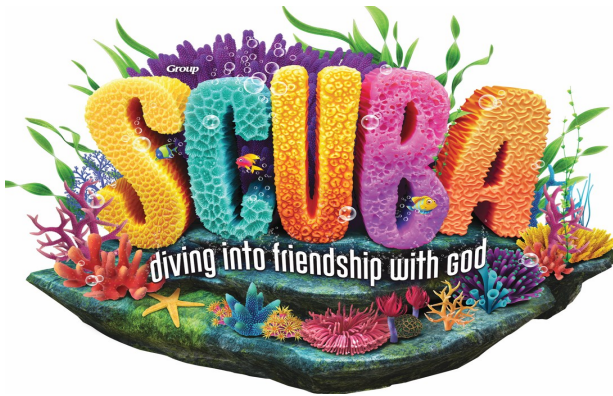
Come dive in with us to learn what it means to be in friendship with God! There are registration forms on the table in the back of the sanctuary, website, or you can use the QR code to register.
