### Ministries and Missions

Valentine's Day is a day we honor love. Did you know that, according to the Britannica Encylopedia, the day may have taken its name from a priest who was martyred about 270 CE. The legend states that the priest signed a letter "from your Valentine" to the jailer's daughter whom he had befriended. Formal messages appeared in the 1500s and by the late 1700's commercially printed cards were being given.

This year, Valentine's Day falls on Ash Wednesday. Isn't it ironic that a day honoring love also marks the beginning of the season where Christians remember the ultimate love that was given to them...the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who suffered, died for our sins and was raised from the dead! <u>Candlelight Meditation & Prayer</u>—Every Wednesday from 12:30-5:30 beginning February 7th, our sanctuary will be open to anyone who would like to come in and pray or leave a prayer request for the pastor.

<u>Pastor's Pantry</u>—Directed by Lorraine Berry, our Pastor's Pantry continues to grow and continues to help our community supplement food shortages. There is currently a Souper Bowl drive going on to stock our Pantry with ready to eat soups. You can donate to that by leaving canned soups in the basket in the Narthex.

<u>Communion Visitation</u>—We have a team of faithful people who, each month, take communion to our shut-ins.

<u>Emergency Response Team</u>—We are trying to get an Emergency Response Team (ERT) to assist members of our community who may be impacted by natural disasters. There is training that will be occurring at Newnan First UMC in March for anyone interested in being part of our ERT team. See Becky for more details.

<u>Sew Blessed</u>—this wonderful group of ladies faithfully meet each week to sew various items which are given to cancer patients, children in Africa, and other worthy causes

<u>L1027</u>—Once a month, Janet Williamson and Frankie Mabry cook food for a group of children and youth that come to our FLC and eat and have fellowship.


